Learning to love carefully means learning to love the things that God says are worthy of our love. His word and His will are short list of the things we are to love. Far too many of us, Christians included, love far too many things that aren’t on this list. By loving the right things, carefully, we will begin to express our love for God in the right ways.

Secondly, learning to love carefully means taking the time to truly love others. Rather than ignoring people we must be intentional about seeing people as worthy of being loved, regardless of who they are. Being indifferent toward people can be the same as hating them.

Be careful with your love. Don’t give it away to those things that aren’t worth being loved; give it freely to people and to the will of God!
