**Best Laid Plans ~ Repentance**

Jonah 3:6-10

You tend to hit what you aim at. This is true in so many areas of life. It can even be true when we wish it weren't. It's called *target fixation*, when someone pays so much attention to their target that they lose focus on everything else around them. The results can be disastrous. The same is true when we lose focus on what it means to repent...

**What Not to Focus On**

*Wrong focus = wrong result*

True repentance is indeed a turning away from our sin and a turn toward Jesus. True repentance also will include a humble spirit. It will include an acknowledgement of our sin, and a desire to have a new identity in Jesus. It will lead us to a place where we desire to know the presence of God in our lives. It will always have a ripple effect—a positive impact on those around us!
