Missions

Why do we focus on missions and on missionaries so much? Aren't we all supposed to be focused on **the** mission and the fact that we are all missionaries?

The answer to that question is easy, and comes in two parts. The first part is that, yes, we are all supposed to be focused on the mission and act as missionaries in our own sphere of influence. That's the point, we do the job of missionary in our own sphere, in a place where we are comfortable. In an environment that is often supportive of our efforts. What a *missionary* does is the same job, just in an environment that may be especially challenging.

Some of the challenges that *missionaries* face include isolation and even loneliness. Many of our missionaries are serving in locations that are far from where they grew up. They often don't have direct access to friends and family like we do. Another issue that *missionaries* face is spiritual warfare. Now, we face the same battle, but we do so surrounded by friends and family in a supportive network. So, while we face a similar battle our easy accessibility to support makes

our battles a little easier. In addition, *missionaries* face a financial struggle that is all too real. Far too often a *missionary* is called home to raise financial support for their efforts on the field. They don't have a job that supports them, they need our support.

So, that's why I like us to focus on missions and missionaries from time to time. We need that contact, and so do our missionaries on the field. They need to know that we are praying for them. They need to know that we are giving to support their work. They need to know that they aren't in this alone.

Chris & Megan Davenport are dedicated to restarting a church in Fredericksburg, VA. The Northern Virginia area continues to experience population growth and is a field that is certainly ripe for the harvest. The church they are working in is the same church where I had the privilege of serving as the assistant pastor from 1998-2002. I am excited for the opportunity to see this new work move forward. I hope you'll pray for and support the Davenports as they labor for the mission!

We must not be contented with praying, without exerting ourselves in the use of means for the obtaining of those things we pray for.
