Jonah 4:1-6

Anger is most often a response that comes out when things don't go the way we want them to go. It is a response that comes along when we feel like we have no other way of expressing our disappointment or frustration. Sometimes, perhaps most of the time, it is a response that isn't justified. Especially when the anger comes at the expense of God.

Jonah was outraged—\_\_\_\_\_

Jonah's anger came from a root of racism. He hated the people of Nineveh **because** they were people of Nineveh, and not people of Israel. He justified it, I am sure, by pointing out the sins of the Ninevites, and reminding himself that he wasn't like "them." If we label others in this same way, we isolate ourselves from them and lose the opportunity to share Jesus.
