**Overcoming Doubt**

Matthew 28:16-20

Doubt can be crippling in the life of a person. Doubt can damage our spiritual health, and if left uncorrected, doubt can lead to a person abandoning their faith in Jesus Christ. While nearly all people will experience periods of doubt in their life, it must not be allowed to become a part of our daily life.

How can we hope to repair the damage that doubt can cause to our spiritual lives? How can we overcome doubt and truly live out our faith? The answer is found in looking at the lives of the disciples as they walked with Jesus.
