There have been people who have looked at this portion of Scripture that have had difficulties with what transpires. It is hard to read; Jericho is to be wiped off the map. Every person in the city is to be killed. Even the animals in the city were to be destroyed. Any rational person would ask the question, "Why?" How we answer that question is critical to our ability to understand God; to our ability to follow Him.

Sin is the issue at the heart of this passage. The people of Jericho had known of the God of Israel for decades, at least. The leaders of Jericho, instead of turning to the Lord, rejected Him. The people of Jericho, with the exception of Rahab, rejected the God of Israel. Rejecting God will always have consequences. God told humanity that the consequence of rejecting Him would be death. Humanity has constantly underestimated the nature of sin. If there is one thing that we must understand, it is this, God ***hates*** sin. Sin is something that is abhorrent to God's nature. Our response must be the same, we must come to ***hate*** sin and also the consequences of that sin.
