The Unfinished Project

There is an unfinished project that the church is supposed to be responsible for completing. In Matthew 24:14, Jesus is telling His disciples about the signs that can be expected when the approach of the very end of these last days is close—that the gospel will be preached to all nations.

Ninety-seven percent of the unreached people in the world live within a narrow band stretching from West Africa to East Asia, it is called the 10/40 Window. From 10 degrees to 40 degrees above the Equator—nearly 4 billion people—over 80 percent of the world’s poor—and most of them have NEVER heard the gospel, not even once. Sadly, only 3 percent of the missionaries on the field are engaged in work inside the 10/40 Window.

On the 30th of August we will be collecting a special offering that will go to the World Missions Offering (WMO) for our Free Will Baptist missionaries around the world. Many of them are actively engaged in reaching some of those within the 10/40 Window. The WMO is crucial to help fund the activities of our missionaries who are working to finish the work, the unfinished project, of preaching the gospel throughout the nations, to reach the unreached and give to them the message of hope, healing, and comfort that the gospel of Jesus Christ contains.

I hope you will join me in praying about how you can support this special offering. While times are hard, our God is more than able to supply our every need. Let’s be faithful, let’s be generous, let’s support the completion of the unfinished project.
