**Forgiveness**

In his excellent work, *The Two Sides of Forgiveness*, Robertson McQuilkin questions the common conventional wisdom that we should forgive everyone of everything. He writes:

*God's love is unlimited, for everyone. Ours ought to be. But God's forgiveness is strictly limited to those who repent. Confusion and guilt overwhelm many of God's people who demand that we do*

*what God does not do—pardon everyone for everything.*

*We can justify this distinction by returning to the two basic meanings of forgive: to remit the guilt and to relinquish resentment. In the sense of remitting guilt, God, in love, forgives a specified few and, in love, does not forgive the majority of humankind. In the sense of relinquishing resentment, however, God forgives everyone. He never for a moment*

*felt bitterness or ill-will against anyone....*

*Love should also shape the way we relate to people, whether friend or enemy. Does love cancel the debt? Sometimes. Does love let go of the resentment? Always.*

Another of those excellent things that anyone who is a disciple of Jesus Christ ought to exhibit, forgiveness; at the very least we need to let go of the resentment we hold toward others.
